Skills Enhancement for Health Surveillance

This evaluation report is the third in a series of reports prepared by the York University Institute for Research on Learning Technologies for Health Canada's Centre for Surveillance Coordination (CSC). Through the Skills Enhancement for Health Surveillance Program, the CSC offers online epidemiology courses to public health professionals across Canada. For the first evaluation of the pilot course, completed in July 2001, we used online surveys, log file analysis, focus group transcripts, and individual interview transcripts. For the present evaluation, we analyzed data from a Web-based survey, modified somewhat from the original, as well as from transcriptions of focus group sessions and individual interviews.
